5 DAY BIBLICAL TOUR IZMIR SUMMARY:

Welcome to Turkey!

We will take you on a journey of ancient temples, 7 biblical churches located within the Aegean Region that will give you a chance to witness the history of humankind from religion perspective. From the altar of legendary, "all mighty" Zeus to the sacred home of holy Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus, many mystic relics are along the way for you to view during an amazing 5 day trip.



5 DAY BIBLICAL TOUR IZMIR ITINERARY:

Day 1 - Izmir - Arrival Day

(Dinner included)

Upon our arrival at Izmir Airport or Kusadasi /Cesme Port, our guide will meet you with your name sign to assist you to transfer to your hotel. Your room card will be given to you and the rest of the day is yours to explore Izmir. Overnight in Izmir.



Day 2 - Pergamum - Thyatira - Izmir

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast we drive to Pergamum, actually called Bergama. It is one of the sites of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 2:12]. Here, we explore the impressive **Acropolis**, the steepest theatre in the world. Then the **Asklepion**, famous medical center of classical times, see the **Altar of Zeus**, which mentioned, as the «Throne of Satan» in the book of Revelation, the marble columns of the **Temple of Trajan**. Moreover, **The Library**, which was foremost in the world and was long a rival of the equally famous Library of Alexandria in Egypt. Its wealth of volumes was estimated at over 200,000. It inspired the invention of parchment.

We also visit the **Red Basilica** (St. Johns Church). Then we continue our visit to **Thyatira**, now called Akhisar, another one of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 2:18 - 24; Acts 16:14]. It was a city famous for purple dyes. We visit the remains of a basilica and some architectural fragments from the Roman period. Lydia, the seller of purple in Philippi, was from Thyatira.

We enjoy a panoramic ride of Smyrna, the third largest city in Turkey and one of the sites of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 2:12 - 17]. Smyrna is a city scarred with a bloody history of trade and warfare. We ascend to Mount Pagus where we visit the **Citadel of Lysimachus**, commander of Alexander the Great, erected in the 4th century BC. We will also see the **Clock Tower**. Check in at the hotel for dinner and overnight in Izmir.

Day 3 - Izmir - Sardis - Philadelphia - Laodicea - Hierapolis

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Today we depart early in the morning to visit one of the most picturesque areas of any of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 3:1 - 4]. **Sardis**, presently Sart. This was the capital of the ancient Lydian kingdom of the 6th century BC, portrayed as a dying church. We visit the great **Temple of Artemis** and the **Temple of Cybele**, which became a Byzantine Church. We will also visit the **restored gymnasium** and **reconstructed Synagogue**. We also see the last several meters of the royal **Persian Road** from Susa to Sardis built by Cyrus the Great and the «golden» river Pactolus. Lunch break will be given en route.

Then we continue our journey to **Philadelphia**, nowadays called Alasehir, another church of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 3:7], and the only church not censured. There we see the remains of a **Byzantine basilica** built of brick, with a bit of high arch and some 11th century frescoes. We drive to the healing city of **Hierapolis**, actually Pamukkale, the white «cotton fortress» where hot mineral water bursts from the earth and cascades over steep cliffs forming pools, channels and stalactites. The therapeutic waters were known to the founders of Hierapolis and of Laodicea in 190 BC. In Hierapolis [Col. 4:13], we visit the **Martyrium of the Apostle Philip** where he martyred during the persecutions ordered by Domitian. Proceed to **Laodicea** (present name Denizli) yet another of the Seven Churches of Asia Minor [Rev. 1:11; 3:14; Col. 2:1; 4:13 - 16]. We see the ancient theatre, the remains of basilica and ancient stone water pipes.

We visit the **Gate of Domitian**, the Arcadian Way, the 2nd century AD Theatre, the Nymphaeum, the Temple of Apollo, the Plutonium and the Necropolis. Check in at hotel for dinner and overnight in Pamukkale.

Day 4 - Ephesus - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Drive to Ephesus to visit the ancient city of **Ephesus** including the **Basilica of St. John**. The Apostle Paul preached to the Ephesians and lived here for three years. This church also received an epistle from him. We tour the spectacular ruins where excavations are still continuing in this once great and important city, which was founded in the 10th century BC. Temple of Artemis, Ephesus ancient sites and Virgin Mary.

Walk through history along marble streets lined with wonderful public buildings, among them the Baths of Scholastica, the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian and the Theatre. The Temple of Diana of



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the Ephesians, another of the seven wonders of the ancient world, was built in this city. We visit the Basilica of St. John. Visit **The House of Virgin Mary**. Overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 5 - Izmir - End of Tour

The shore lined with old wooden villas, palaces of marble, fortresses, and small fishing villages. During the excursion, you will see the magnificent sights of the following attractions from your boat. See Dolmabahce Palace, and further along, the parks and imperial pavilions of Yildiz Palace. On the coastal edge of this park, is Ciragan Palace, 300 meters of its marble facade faces the shore. At Ortakoy a great variety of artists, gather every sunday to display their work along the street. Ortakoy is a symbol of tolerance with a church, a mosque and a synagogue existing side by side for centuries.

RUMELI FORTRESS (view from boat), Built by Mehmet the Conqueror in 1452 prior to the conquest of Istanbul was completed in only four months to control and protect the infamous Bosphorus passage. It is one of the most beautiful works of military architecture anywhere in the world. BEYLERBEYI PALACE (view from boat), is the summer residence of Ottoman sultans exists in its original renovated glory featuring original antique furniture and magnificent gardens with the Harem on the Asian side of Istanbul. Lunch break at the Turkish restaurant. After the lunch we will then take you to the **GRAND COVERED BAZAAR** In this labyrinth of streets and passages are more than 4,000 shops with each trade having its own area: the goldsmiths' street, the carpet sellers, Turkish arts and crafts, such as hand painted ceramic plates, hand-honed copperware, brassware and trays, water ewers, onyx-ware and meerscham pipes. After the tour transfer back to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 4 - Istanbul - Troy - Canakkale

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast, we depart for **Gallipoli**, through the European lands of Turkey. Cross the Dardanelles Strait by ferry - boat. Lunch break will be given en route. Visit ancient **Troy**, see the legendary walls and the replica of the wooden horse. Drive to Canakkale, that lends its name to the Straits of the Dardanelles (in antiquity it was called Hellespont). This narrow passage connects the waters of the Mediterranean Sea, the Aegean Sea, the Sea of Marmara, and further north opens into the Black Sea, on the southern shores of the former USSR. Check in at the hotel followed by dinner. Overnight in Canakkale.

Day 5 - Pergamon - Thyatira - Izmir

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast at our hotel in Canakkale, we drive to **Pergamum**, actually called Bergama. It is one of



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the sites of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 2:12]. Here we explore the impressive **Acropolis**, the steepest theatre in the world. Then the **Asklepieion**, famous medical centre of classical times, see the **Altar of Zeus**, which mentioned as the «Throne of Satan» in the book of Revelation. Moreover, the marble columns of the **Temple of Trajan** and the **Library**, which was foremost in the world and was, long a rival of the equally famous Library of Alexandria in Egypt. Its wealth of volumes was estimated at over 200, 000. It inspired the invention of parchment.

We also visit the **Red Basilica (St. Johns Church)**. Lunch break will be given en route. Then we continue our visit to **Thyatira**, now called Akhisar, another one of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 2:18 - 24; Acts 16:14]. It was a city famous for purple dyes. We visit the remains of a basilica and some architectural fragments from the Roman period. Lydia, the seller of purple in Philippi, was from Thyatira.

Before we check in at the hotel in Izmir, we enjoy a panoramic ride of **Smyrna**, the third largest city in Turkey and one of the sites of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 2:12 - 17]. Smyrna is a city scarred with a bloody history of trade and warfare. We ascend to Mount Pagus where we visit the Citadel of Lysimachos, commander of Alexander the Great, erected in the 4th century BC. We will also see the **Clock Tower**. Check in at the hotel for dinner. Overnight in Izmir.

Day 6 - Izmir - Sardis - Philadelphia - Hierapolis

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Today we depart early in the morning to one of the most picturesque areas of any of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 3:1 - 4], **Sardis**, presently Sart. This was the capital of the ancient Lydian kingdom of the 6th century BC, portrayed as a dying church. We visit the great **Temple of Artemis** and the **Temple of Cybele**, which became a Byzantine Church. We will also visit the restored gymnasium and reconstructed Synagogue. We also see the last several meters of the royal Persian Road from Susa to Sardis built by Cyrus the Great and the «golden» river Pactolos. Lunch en route.

Then we continue our journey to **Philadelphia**, nowadays called Alasehir, another church of the Seven Churches of Asia [Rev. 1:11; 3:7], and the only church not censured. There we see the remains of a Byzantine basilica built of brick, with a bit of high arch and some 11th century frescoes. We drive to the healing city of **Hierapolis**, actually Pamukkale, the white «cotton fortress» where hot mineral water bursts from the earth and cascades over steep cliffs forming pools, channels and stalactites. The therapeutic waters were known to the founders of Hierapolis and of Laodicea in 190 BC. In Hierapolis [Col. 4:13] we visit the **Martyrium of the Apostle Philip** where he was martyred during the persecutions ordered by Domitian.

We visit the Gate of Domitian, the Arcadian Way, the 2nd century AD Theatre, the Nymphaion, the Temple of Apollo, the Plutonium and the Necropolis. Dinner and overnight. Pamukkale

Day 7 - Laodicea - Aphrodisias - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

We depart for **Laodicea** (present name Denizli) yet another of the Seven Churches of Asia Minor [Rev. 1:11; 3:14; Col. 2:1; 4:13 - 16]. We see the ancient theatre, the remains of basilica and ancient stone water pipes. **Aphrodisias** is our next stop. We visit the best - preserved ancient stadium ever excavated where the seating capacity was 30, 000. We see the odeon with its extraordinary blue marble stage, the Temple of Aphrodite that marks the site of ancient veneration, **Hadrian's Bath** and the **Bishop's Palace**, part of a building christened by the archaeologists. Lunch en route.

Drive to Kusadasi, in the Turkish language, Kusadasi, this lovely and peaceful little port and fashionable resort, means "Island of Birds". It is built along the shores of a glittering bay, around a tiny islet covered with pine - trees and flowers. The terraced town overlooks the most beautiful bay of the Aegean Sea and seems it has been created purely for the delight of the holidaymaker. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 8 - Ephesus - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we enjoy a visit to the ancient city of **Ephesus** including the **Basilica of St. John**. The Apostle Paul preached to the Ephesians and lived here for three years. This church also received an epistle from him. We tour the spectacular ruins where excavations still continue in this once great and important city, which was founded in the 10th century BC. Walk through history along marble streets lined with wonderful public buildings, among them the Baths of Scholastica, the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian and the Theatre. The Temple of Diana of the Ephesians, another of the seven wonders of the ancient world, was built in this city. Lunch en route. We visit the Basilica of St. John. We visit **The House of Virgin Mary** where she spent her latest years. Overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 9 - Izmir - End of Tour

(Breakfast included)

14 DAY BIBLICAL TOUR TURKEY ITINERARY:

Day 1 - Istanbul - Arrival Day

Upon our arrival at Istanbul International Airport, your guide will meet, assist and transfer you to the hotel. Istanbul's original name is Byzantium then Constantinople. It is a most fascinating city, which actually crosses two continents Europe and Asia. It is a city of amalgamation of bazaars, minarets, mosques, churches, palaces, and restaurants catering to every one's taste, museums, customs and twelve million people. Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 2 - Istanbul City Tour

(Breakfast included)

Our journey begins in Istanbul, the only city in the world situated on two continents. Today we rediscover the Byzantine and Ottoman treasures of Istanbul. We visit **Hippodrome** and the Obelisk brought from Egypt. Then our next visit is the **Blue Mosque** with its six minarets. Afternoon we will visit the **Topkapi Palace**, which was the residence of the Ottoman sultans, with its fabulous treasure chambers. After the lunch, Murtis Tour will take you to the **Grand Spice Bazaar** which is a unique atmosphere with reasonable prices for your shopping. Here you will find; Exotic Spices and Herbs, Turkish Baklava, Turkish Delights, Turkish Coffee, nuts and fruits, small souvenirs such as Ceramic Handicrafts, Evil Eyes totems, all natural olive oil, soaps and many other goods in Souvenir Shops and stores. After the tour, transfer back to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 3 - Istanbul - Adana - Tarsus - Seleucia - Antioch

(Breakfast included)

Early morning flight to Adana, the country's fourth largest city. Adana is situated some thirty miles east of Tarsus, birthplace of the Apostle Paul. Upon arrival drive to Tarsus and visit the **Apostle Pauls well**, the **Gate of Cleopatra**, and the latest excavations. Then we visit the archaeological remains of **Seleucia**, the port from which Paul, Barnabas and John Mark departed from Antioch on the first missionary journey (Acts 13:4). Drive to Antioch for overnight Adana

Day 4 - Antioch - Cappadocia

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

It was here at Antioch on the Orontes that believers were first called "Christians" (Acts 11:26). Visit **The Cave** where they met in secret. Paul and Silas departed from here on the second missionary journey (Acts 15:35 - 36). Discover the impact of leaders such as Ignatius of Antioch and John Chrysostom. In Acts 2:9, pilgrims from Cappadocia were assembled with the thousands in Jerusalem on the Day of Pentecost when they received the initial baptism of the Holy Spirit and heard the Apostle Peter preach his powerful message. We will travel to Cappadocia scenic **Ihlara Valley**, where early Christians carved some 3, 500 cave churches from the tufa rock. The beauty and quaintness of these chapels, with numerous wall paintings and Christian symbols, is astonishing. Persecuted Christians - tens of thousands of them - escaping into the earth to flee Arab invaders in the tenth century, tunneled out more than twenty underground cities of refuge here in Cappadocia. Such cities, with carved rooms for kitchens, sleeping quarters, stables, and chapels for worship, descend five to ten stories into the earth. At **Ozkonak Underground City**, one of the best preserved of these cities, you will enjoy your own guided tour into this amazing region. Overnight in a Cappadocia.

Day 5 - Cappadocia City Tour

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Cappadocia, with its center in Caesarea (Kayseri), was once the heart of the Hittite Kingdom of the Old Testament. This vast area is one of the most photogenic landscapes in the world. Extraordinary rock formations have become symbolic of this region, where you will enjoy the **Valley of the Fairy Chimneys** and **Goreme's breathtaking Open Air Museum**. Watch the potters at their craft, in the famous pottery; producing town of Avanos. Finally, savour the natural wonders of the **Citadel of Uchisar** and **Zelve Valley**. Overnight in a Cappadocia.

Day 6 - Sultanhan - Lystra - Iconium - Konya

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Drive to the **Sultanhani Caravansary** for a fascinating look at one of the rest stops for ancient camel caravans. Along the trade routes, such caravansaries appeared at intervals of some twenty - five miles, the average distance that camels could travel in a day. Continue on to **Lystra**, where a mob stoned Paul during his first journey (Acts 14:6 - 19), and where Timothy joined him during the second journey (Acts 16:1 - 3). Depart for **Iconium**, where Paul preached and encouraged believers during his first missionary journey (Acts 14:1 - 6). Iconium was once the home of the sect of mystical Muslims called **Whirling Dervishes**. Overnight in a Konya.

Day 7 - Pisidian - Antioch - Colossea - Pamukkale

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Drive to **Antioch of Pisidia**, where nearly the whole city came to hear Paul preach during his first missionary journey (Acts 13:14 - 52). The marvelous excavations include the ancient church and the great first - century Temple of Augustus. Today, you will travel the Royal Road that once connected Ephesus with distant Babylon. Visit the unexcavated site of ancient **Colossae** by the village of Honaz. The Apostle Paul wrote one of his prison epistles to the church at Colossae, a city situated on the Lycus River. Then drive to Hierapolis (Pamukkale) and explore incredible excavations; including a Byzantine church, the Great Theatre, the Temple of Apollo, and the Plutonium, which pagan cults once called "the entrance to hell." Examine the intriguing sites of the Churches of Revelation. At **Hierapolis** (Pamukkale), enjoy the "Cotton Castles" of brilliant white calcium rock formations and hot - water travertines, where hot mineral waters emerge from the earth and cascade over cliffs. As the water-cools, the calcium precipitates and clings to the cliffs, forming snowy white travertines (waterfalls of white stone), which give credence to the name Pamukkale, meaning "cotton castle". This enchanting place is one of the natural wonders of Asia Minor. The churches here in Hierapolis, Colossae, and Laodicea once flourished under the ministry of Epaphras (Colossians 4:12 - 13). Overnight in Pamukkale.

Day 8 - Laodicea - Philadelphia - Sardis

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Laodicea** (Rev. 3:14 - 22), which will take you back to the first century. At **Philadelphia** (Rev. 3:7 - 12), your Bible will come alive as you read it in light of firsthand study. This city was located along the important trade route that linked Pergamum in the north with Laodicea to the south. In A.D. 17, an earthquake devastated twelve Asian cities, including Philadelphia, and for a time the people lived in fear of aftershocks. Philadelphia was rebuilt with help from Emperor Tiberius. At **Sardis** (Rev. 3:1 - 5), your thoughts will turn to the Old Testament period following the 586 B.C. destruction of Jerusalem. That was the time when the phrase "rich as Croesus" originated. Croesus (560 - 546 B.C..) was the king of Lydia, and Sardis was his capital. Gold was discovered in the Pactolus River at Sardis and it was here that coinage began, as we know it. Cyrus and the Persians defeated and captured Croesus for all his wealth and made Sardis the administrative center for the western part of their empire. The fabled Royal Road connected Sardis with the Persian cities to the east. Sardis was the hardest hit of the twelve cities destroyed in the earthquake of A.D. 17. Emperor Tiberius, according to the Annals of the historian Tacitus, gave much relief towards its rebuilding. Your visit to Sardis will include the imperial court and the ancient Jewish synagogue. You will rest in the shade of the Temple of Artemis, while studying in the light of prophetic Scripture. Dine and overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 9 - Miletus - Didyma - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Drive to **Miletus**, home of ancient philosopher Thales (640 - 546 B.C.), one of the fathers of Greek geometry, astronomy, and philosophy. It was here, in the first Christian century, that the Apostle Paul,



on his third missionary journey, called for the Ephesians elders and preached a powerful message to them (Acts 20:15 - 38).. It was also here that Paul left his friend Trophimus, who was too ill to continue (II Timothy 4:20). As a port at the mouth of the Meander River, Miletus was a natural outlet for Phrygian trade. Like the one at Ephesus, however, Miletus's sea harbor eventually filled with silt, and commerce dwindled. The city's remote quietness makes it special to devout students of Scripture. Its ancient ruins include the marvelous 15, 000 - seat theatre. Nearby, at **Didyma**, visit the massive Temple to Apollo, one of the most impressive sites in Anatolia. Ordinary people did not reside in ancient Didyma. This was home only to a priestly family whose oracle came from Delphi and who lived in luxury, as they guarded their temple treasures supplied by the people they deceived. Continue to Kusadasi for overnight.

Day 10 - Ephesus Tour

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Ephesus** (Rev. 2:1 - 7), major port city on the Aegean, was the commercial, political, and religious center of all of Asia Minor. After a lunatic completely burned, the Temple of Diana (Artemis) on the night that Alexander the Great was born in 356 B.C. the Ephesians worked for 120 years to complete a magnificent reconstructed temple, one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. The city became part of the Roman Empire in the second century B.C. As a Roman capital of Asia Minor, Ephesus boasted a population approaching 250,000 people. The Apostle Paul's first visit to Ephesus was brief—during his second missionary tour (Acts 18:19 - 21). His second visit lasted about three years—during his third missionary tour (Acts 19:1 to 20:31). Luke's account of the worship of Diana appears in Acts 19:34 - 35. The Great Theatre (stadium) mentioned in Acts 19:29 - 31 could seat 25,000 people. Walk the marble - paved street with grooves made by chariot wheels. See the Fountain of Trojan, the Library of Celsus and the Great Theatre. Visit the Chapel of the Virgin Mary (Double Church), where the Third Ancient Council convened. We visit **The House of Virgin Mary** where she spent her latest years. Enjoy **St. Johns Basilica** (built on the site of the Apostle John's tomb) and ponder the remains of the Temple of Diana. Overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 11 - Thytira - Pergamon

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Today, we will visit our final two of the Seven Churches of Revelation. At **Thytira** (Rev. 2: 18 - 28), you will see the ruins of an ancient commercial center, located in the fertile valley where the trade route passed. One of the towns cloth and dye merchants was a woman named Lydia, who conducted business as far away as Philippi, where she became the first European convert to Christianity, during Paul's second missionary journey (Acts 16:11 - 15). A most memorable experience will be **Pergamum**, with its **Acropolis** and Great Theatre, the steepest of the ancient world. Revelation 2:12 - 16 describes the city as "where Satan's seat is," a reference to the altar of Zeus, where we pause for reflection on the fulfillment of Scripture. Nearby, visit the **Red Basilica**; once a pagan temple, it later converted into a Christian church. Finally, walk through the Pergamum **Asclepion**, the famous medical center of antiquity. Overnight in Izmir.

Day 12 - Troy - Alexandra Troas - Assos - Canakkale

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Enjoy a fascinating visit to recent excavations of ancient **Troy**, made legendary by Homer's story of Helen and the Trojans' wooden horse. Then drive to **Troas**, founded about 300 B.C. by one of the generals of Alexandria the Great. During the Apostle Paul's second missionary journey, it was from Troas that he received the "Macedonian call" to Europe. This is where Luke's account changes from "they" to "we" (Acts 16:6 - 12), indicating that he joined Paul's team at Troas. Returning from Macedonia during his third journey, Paul was in Troas for a week, when the young man Eutychus fell from the third loft as Paul preached. Paul soon walked some thirty miles to Assos, where we will follow the apostle's footsteps to the old city walls (Acts 20:5 - 14). You will walk the old marketplace of Assos and see the council chamber and Temple to Athena. Overnight in Canakkale.



Day 13 - Nicea - Istanbul

(Breakfast included)

Drive to **Nicea** through Bursa. At Nicea, you will see remains of Constantine's palace, now covered by the water at the shore of Lake Iznik. It was here in this palace chapel that the First Ancient Church Council convened in A.D. 325 to produce the Nicene Creed. Day 10 – Pamukkale City Tour

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Laodicea** (Rev. 3:14 - 22), which will take you back to the first century and was condemned by St. John in Revelation Acts (4:15). Then drive to Hierapolis (Pamukkale) and explore incredible excavations; including a Byzantine church, the Great Theatre, the Temple of Apollo, and the Plutonium, which pagan cults once called "the entrance to hell." Examine the intriguing sites of the Churches of Revelation. At **Hierapolis** (Pamukkale), enjoy the "Cotton Castles" of brilliant white calcium rock formations and hot - water travertines, where hot mineral waters emerge from the earth and cascade over cliffs. As the water-cools, the calcium precipitates and clings to the cliffs, forming snowy white travertines (waterfalls of white stone), which give credence to the name Pamukkale, meaning "cotton castle". This enchanting place is one of the natural wonders of Asia Minor. The churches here in Hierapolis, Colossae, and Laodicea once flourished under the ministry of Epaphras (Colossians 4:12 - 13). Dinner and overnight in Pamukkale.

Day 11 - Philadelphia - Sardes - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Philadelphia** (Rev. 3:7 - 12), your Bible will come alive as you read it in light of firsthand study. This city was located along the important trade route that linked Pergamum in the north with Laodicea to the south. In A.D. 17, an earthquake devastated twelve Asian cities, including Philadelphia, and for a time the people lived in fear of aftershocks. Philadelphia was rebuilt with help from Emperor Tiberius. At **Sardis** (Rev. 3:1 - 5), your thoughts will turn to the Old Testament period following the 586 B.C. destruction of Jerusalem. That was the time when the phrase "rich as Croesus" originated. Croesus (560 - 546 B.C..) was the king of Lydia, and Sardis was his capital. Gold was discovered in the Pactolus River at Sardis and it was here that coinage began, as we know it. Cyrus and the Persians defeated and captured Croesus for all his wealth and made Sardis the administrative center for the western part of their empire. The fabled Royal Road connected Sardis with the Persian cities to the east. Sardis was the hardest hit of the twelve cities destroyed in the earthquake of A.D. 17. Emperor Tiberius, according to the Annals of the historian Tacitus, gave much relief towards its rebuilding. Your visit to Sardis will include the imperial court and the ancient Jewish synagogue. You will rest in the shade of the Temple of Artemis, while studying in the light of prophetic Scripture. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

Later return to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Adana.

Day 5 - Antakya - Antioch - Mersin

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Full Day excursion to Antakya (Antioch). Here Jesus followers were first called Christians (Acts 11:26) Peter, Paul and also Barnabas preached here. Visit **St. Peters Grotto** and the exquisite **Mosaic Museum**. View the old city of **Iskenderun** before beginning the return, driving to Mersin for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 6 - Anamur - Antalya

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Depart westward along the Mediterranean shoreline, a famous coastal road. Take a lunch break in Anamur. See City of the **Monophystie Archbishop of Seleucia**. Dinner and overnight in Antalya.

Day 7 – Antalya Side/Perge & Aspendos Ancient City

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

Continue to the ancient city of **SIDE**, the old port where Paul, Barnabas and Mark landed during their missionary journeys. Later they sailed from here to Antioch. Than visit **PERGE**, where St. Paul preached when arriving from Cyprus (Acts 13 - 14), and to **ASPENDOS** with its magnificent theater. Next, drive to Antalya for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 8 – Pamukkale City Tour



(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Laodicea** (Rev. 3:14 - 22), which will take you back to the first century and was condemned by St. John in Revelation Acts (4:15). Then drive to Hierapolis (Pamukkale) and explore incredible excavations; including a Byzantine church, the Great Theatre, the Temple of Apollo, and the Plutonium, which pagan cults once called "the entrance to hell." Examine the intriguing sites of the Churches of Revelation. At **Hierapolis** (Pamukkale), enjoy the "Cotton Castles" of brilliant white calcium rock formations and hot - water travertines, where hot mineral waters emerge from the earth and cascade over cliffs. As the water-cools, the calcium precipitates and clings to the cliffs, forming snowy white travertines (waterfalls of white stone), which give credence to the name Pamukkale, meaning "cotton castle". This enchanting place is one of the natural wonders of Asia Minor. The churches here in Hierapolis, Colossae, and Laodicea once flourished under the ministry of Epaphras (Colossians 4:12 - 13). Dinner and overnight in Pamukkale.

Day 9 - Philadelphia - Sardes - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Philadelphia** (Rev. 3:7 - 12), your Bible will come alive as you read it in light of firsthand study. This city was located along the important trade route that linked Pergamum in the north with Laodicea to the south. In A.D. 17, an earthquake devastated twelve Asian cities, including Philadelphia, and for a time the people lived in fear of aftershocks. Philadelphia was rebuilt with help from Emperor Tiberius. At **Sardis** (Rev. 3:1 - 5), your thoughts will turn to the Old Testament period following the 586 B.C. destruction of Jerusalem. That was the time when the phrase "rich as Croesus" originated. Croesus (560 - 546 B.C..) was the king of Lydia, and Sardis was his capital. Gold was discovered in the Pactolus River at Sardis and it was here that coinage began, as we know it. Cyrus and the Persians defeated and captured Croesus for all his wealth and made Sardis the administrative center for the western part of their empire. The fabled Royal Road connected Sardis with the Persian cities to the east. Sardis was the hardest hit of the twelve cities destroyed in the earthquake of A.D. 17. Emperor Tiberius, according to the Annals of the historian Tacitus, gave much relief towards its rebuilding. Your visit to Sardis will include the imperial court and the ancient Jewish synagogue. You will rest in the shade of the Temple of Artemis, while studying in the light of prophetic Scripture. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 10 - Ephesus - Kusadasi

(Breakfast and Dinner included)

After breakfast drive to **Ephesus** (Rev. 2:1 - 7), major port city on the Aegean, was the commercial, political, and religious center of all of Asia Minor. After a lunatic completely burned, the Temple of Diana (Artemis) on the night that Alexander the Great was born in 356 B.C. the Ephesians worked for 120 years to complete a magnificent reconstructed temple, one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. The city became part of the Roman Empire in the second century B.C. As a Roman capital of Asia Minor, Ephesus boasted a population approaching 250,000 people. The Apostle Paul's first visit to Ephesus was brief—during his second missionary tour (Acts 18:19 - 21). His second visit lasted about three years—during his third missionary tour (Acts 19:1 to 20:31). Luke's account of the worship of Diana appears in Acts 19:34 - 35. The Great Theatre (stadium) mentioned in Acts 19:29 - 31 could seat 25,000 people. Walk the marble - paved street with grooves made by chariot wheels. See the Fountain of Trojan, the Library of Celsus and the Great Theatre. Visit the Chapel of the Virgin Mary (Double Church), where the Third Ancient Council convened. We visit **The House of Virgin Mary** where she spent her latest years. Enjoy **St. Johns Basilica** (built on the site of the Apostle John's tomb) and ponder the remains of the Temple of Diana. Overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 11 - Izmir (Smyrna)

(Breakfast and dinner included)

This morning take a beautiful drive to Izmir (ancient Smyrna), After visiting the **St. Policarp church** in Izmir. Continue to in Akhisar, ancient commercial place in connection with TROY and Sardes. Dinner



and overnight in Izmir.

Day 12 - Pergamon

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast early departure to **Pergamum**, with its **Acropolis** and Great Theatre, the steepest of the ancient world. Revelation 2:12 - 16 describes the city as "where Satan's seat is," a reference to the altar of Zeus, where we pause for reflection on the fulfillment of Scripture. Nearby, visit the **Red Basilica**; once a pagan temple, it later converted into a Christian church. Finally, walk through the Pergamum **Asclepion**, the famous medical center of antiquity. Dinner and Overnight in Izmir.

Day 13 - Pergamon - Nicea – Istanbul Half Day City Tour

(Breakfast included)

After breakfast long drive to **Nicea** through Bursa. At Nicea, you will see remains of Constantine's palace, now covered by the water at the shore of Lake Iznik. It was here in this palace chapel that the First Ancient Church Council convened in A.D. 325 to produce the Nicene Creed. Enjoy Nicea's St. Sophia Church, where the Seventh Church Council convened in 787. Continue to Istanbul. We visit **Hippodrome** and the Obelisk brought from Egypt. Then our next visit is the **Blue Mosque** with its six minarets. Overnight in Istanbul

Day 14 – Istanbul Half Day City Tour/Bosphorus Cruise

(Breakfast included)

Our journey begins in Istanbul, the only city in the world situated on two continents. Today we rediscover the Byzantine and Ottoman treasures of Istanbul. We visit **St. Sofia**, the (church of the sacred wisdom), converted to a mosque from a Christian basilica after the fall of Constantinople in 1453. We will visit the **Topkapi Palace**, which was the residence of the Ottoman sultans, with its fabulous treasure chambers. Lunch break at 13:00 pm. After the lunch, Murtis Tour will take you to the **Grand Spice Bazaar** which is a unique atmosphere with reasonable prices for your shopping. During the excursion, you will see the magnificent sights of the following attractions from your boat. See Dolmabahce Palace, and further along, the parks and imperial pavilions of Yildiz Palace. On the coastal edge of this park, is Ciragan Palace, 300 meters of its marble facade faces the shore. At Ortakoy a great variety of artists, gather every Sunday to display their work along the street. Ortakoy is a symbol of tolerance with a church, a mosque and a synagogue existing side by side for centuries.

RUMELI FORTRESS (view from boat), Built by Mehmet the Conqueror in 1452 prior to the conquest of Istanbul was completed in only four months to control and protect the infamous Bosphorus passage. It is one of the most beautiful works of military architecture anywhere in the world. **BEYLERBEYI PALACE** (view from boat), is the summer residence of Ottoman sultans exists in its original renovated glory featuring original antique furniture and magnificent gardens with the Harem on the Asian side of Istanbul. Return to the hotel for overnight.

Day 15 – Istanbul to Kavala - Border Crossing

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast we will start our journey to border of Greece. At noon we are meet by our Greek guide as we drive from the Greek/Turkish borders to Kavala passing by **Alexandroupolis**. Dinner and overnight at Hotel in Kavala.

Day 16 - Kavala - Philippi - Thessaloniki

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Day 17 - Thessaloniki - Veria - Meteora - Kalambaka

(Breakfast and dinner included)

In the morning, after a short city tour of Thessaloniki, we drive to **Berea**. We see the Byzantine mosaic in the monument commemorating his preaching. Lunch on your own. Then we proceed our drive to **Meteora** where we visit in the afternoon the fantastic and breathtaking Byzantine monasteries. Monks seeking isolation and spiritual salvation first built those monasteries in the 14th century. Dinner and overnight at Kalambaka.

Day 18 - Kalambaka - Delphi - Athens

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast at Hotel drive to Delphi, we visit the archaeological site of **Delphi: the Sanctuary of Apollo, the Treasury of the Athenians, and the Museum** containing such masterpieces of ancient Greek sculpture as the bronze Charioteer and the famous athlete Aghias.
