Turkey is rich in natural beauty and outside the major cities you will get to visit a way of life that is as traditional as Turkey could be. On this tour you will visit the natural villages of Turkey and get to see the natural beauty of Turkey. There are great opportunties to get involved with the villagers and their way of life. You get to sample many of the locally grown natural fruits, nuts and berries as well as eat and drink just like a local. This tour is our highlight of our Eco Tours. We highly reccommend this tour to anyone who wants to discover the real Turkey. The villages that we visit are not full of tourists anda re off the beaten track. This is a very new destination and you will be made very welcome.



8 DAY ECOTOURISM TOUR ITINERARY:

Day 1 - Ankara to Amasya - Tokat

(Dinner included)

Pick up from Ankara Airport and depart for Amasya. A little about Amasya: In Amasya, one can see the remnants of the Hellenistic, the Roman, the Byzantine, the Seljuk, the Ilhanli, and the Ottoman civilizations, as well as many important remains belonging to the first years of the Republic of Turkey. The museums of this historical city contain cultural treasures, from many civilizations. Amasya is endowed with historical and cultural opulence, and the city is also very rich in natural beauty. The thermal springs around Amasya are very famous. Amasya Yaliboyu Houses are the best remaining of Ottoman architecture. These buildings usually have two storeys and they are now being restored by a foundation called AKTAV. (The Foundation of Protecting Cultural and Natural wealth). Amasya is also famous for its apples, cherries, peaches and okra. If you would like to enjoy the beautiful nature within the city's deeply rooted cultural tradition, then Amasya is one of the most exciting places for you.. Dinner and overnight in Tokat City at Silk Road Museum Hotel – Deveciler Hanı.

Day 2 - Tokat City Tour - Turhal - Zile

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast, you will depart from Tokat City Tour. we will visit the famous Tokat Castle, two major

and awarded Museums (historical and ethnographical) in downtown area along with Wooden Historical Residences all around us. We will witness 900 years of history in 900 steps, world renowned Turkish Baths as well as Clock Tower in downtown. We have Lunch break and after lunch depart for Zile. In the 3rd century B. C., the region was occupied by the contingents of Alexander the Great's Macedonian army, but many insurrections had also taken place in this era as the Macedonian occupiers couldn't build up a total control on the region. Today we will visit a local orchard depending on the season we visit Cherry Orchards, Apples, Grapes and Pears. This area is extremly famous for its fruit and you will get the opportunity to taste some of this excellent naturally grown fruit. All fruit grown here is organic and you we certainly taste the difference. In the evening we will arrive at Cakir Cali Koyu we will have diner with the local people in the village houses. Dinner and overnight in Cakir Cali.

Day 3 - Cakircali Village

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Free day in the village. The best choice to see a natural village in Turkey. Cakircali village was a village with only 80 houses. However, there are now only 25 houses in this village because of migration to big cities. The village is small and nice sitting between high mountains where you will see the fight between people and nature by seeing fields, forests, canyons and some similar places where the natural atmosphere did not yet changed. Besides that, you will notice the hospitableness of the people who live there. We hope you will get to see a traditional village wedding ceremony. These ceremonies, last a good a few days, with many foods and drinks, various kind of instruments and different local dances. There is a possibility that there will be village festivals during your time here which is a great opportunity to see how the local people enjoy themselves. Day 1 - Istanbul - Arrival Day

(Dinner included)

Welcome to Turkey, arrival into Istanbul. Transfer from airport & check in to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

Day 2 - Istanbul City Tour

Day 3 - Seven Lakes and Abant Lake Tour

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Visiting 7 lakes which are found to be diffirent height points from each other and at the same time connected with each other on foot. You find seven small lakes in a valley formed as the result of a landslide: Buyukgol (Big Lake), Seringol (Cool Lake), Deringol (Deep Lake), Nazligol (Elegant Lake), Kucukgol (Small Lake), Incegol (Thin Lake) and Sazligol (Reedy Lake). The lakes are on an area of 550 hectares, while the National Park they are located in is 2019 hectares. The area is among the best-known trekking places. There are only small bungalows belonging to the Forestry Ministry where visitors who want to linger can stay. Deer and trout production farms are also in the area. An entrance fee is paid according to the type of vehicle and the number of visitors. Tables, firepits and fountains are available for picnickers. Fishing is available in Yedigoller between April 1st and September 1st. We will then have some lunch and depart for Abant Lake. Abant is most probably the most famous lake in Turkey. It is 30 kilometers away from Bolu, and you can reach it from the crossing on the Ankara-Istanbul highway. The lake is at the end of a 22-kilometer drive. The seven-kilometer walk around the lake offers a great opportunity to enjoy the area. Those who don't wish to walk can ride horseback or complete the tour on a horse cart. Abant lake is surrounded with pine trees. The manner in which the lake was formed is a topic of discussion. Its deepest point is 45 meters. The countryside is pleasantly different in each season. Water lilies embellish the surface in summer. It is also famous for its trout. Later, we will have free time for shopping at the bazaar in the village. Dinner and overnight near Abant in traditional village house.

Day 4 - Safranbolu

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast, We have a walk to the historical Safranbolu Bazaar. We then visit Cinci Hodja Caravanserai, Cici Hodja Bath, Kaymakamlar House (Museum), Izzet Mehmet Pasha mosque and more. Continue to Kastamonu, we visit government house, Kaya tomb, Seyh Saban-i Veli Mausoleum, Nasrullah Seyh Mosque and more historical sites. Dinner and overnight in authentic wooden houses in Safranbolu.

Day 5 - Ilgarini Cave Pinarbasi

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Today, we will depart for Ilgarini Cave, which is in the region of Pinarbasi (northwest of Kastamonu), it is one of the largest caves in Turkey. It is a wonderful place for trekking and exploration off the beaten path. The cave had been composed by two sections. The cave is an active one and the stalactite and stalagmite activity still continues. A chapel and a burial ground was found in this cave. Ilgarini Cave was chosen as the 4th biggest cave in the world. There is no roads to Ilgarini Cave so we will be trekking to the Cave so make sure you bring suitable footwear. Dinner and overnight in Pinarbasi.

Day 6 - Ilica Waterfall & Valla Canyon

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast we will visit Ilica Waterfall which is at Kure national Park, near Pinarbasi, which is in the town and district of the Kastamonu Province in the Black Sea region of Turkey. After lunch you can either relax in the surrondings of this beautifull natural Turkish village or you can take a walk to the Valla Canyon. The walk to the Canyon is about 4km. The chimaera, or mythical fire-breathing monster with the head of a lion, the torso of a goat, and the rear of a snake that allegedly roams the hills that are actually a series of eternal flames flickering along the rocky slopes above the ancient city of Olympos, which would account for the Lycians worship of the fire god Hephaestos (Vulcan). But never fear: According to legend, the Chimaera was slained by Bellerophon on his winged horse Pegasus. The fires are caused by the combustion of a predominantly methane gas mixture seeping out of the earth. Dinner and overnight in Olympos at Tree Houses & Bungalows.

Day 8 - Olympos Free Day

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Rest day in Olympos. Enjoy the sunshine and take in the views of natural magnificent beach & crystal clear sea, onto exploring the city, shop in the local markets, relax on the beach or enjoy with its unspoilt scenery in fascinating Lycian history. This part of Turkey's Mediterranean coast is the perfect place for an unforgettable holiday. Dinner and overnight in Olympos at Tree Houses & Bungalows.

Day 9 - Termessos and Duden Waterfall

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast, we depart for Termessos. The ruins of the city of Termessos are perched on a 1050 metre high plateau on the west face of the Gulluk Mountain (Solymos) found in Mt. Gulluk National Park on the northwest of Antalya. A wild and splendid landscape surrounds the monumental traces of this city. Termessians (Pisidian people) lived in their impregnable fortress city and guarded their independence fiercely. Alexander the Great was fought off in 333 B. C. and the Romans accepted Termessos as an independent ally, not as a subject city in 70 B. C. Duden Waterfall It is situated in DSI state park. It has been used as a settlement area dating back to 5th century BC. There are



ancient graves built near the waterfall, dating back to 3rd century BC. Discharge of the of the river is 25 million m3 per year and it is 25 meters in depth. Dinner and overnight in Antalya.

Day 10 - Antalya - Egirdir

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast, we depart for Egirdir. Egirdir is on the southern tip of the most beautiful Pisidian lakes. Egirdir is a fine place to stop in the midst of your journey for two days of quiet rest and contempation. Dinner and overnight in Egirdir.

Day 11 - Egirdir Free Day

Day 12 - Egirdir - Konya and Cappadocia

(Breakfast and dinner included)

This morning, we drive to Konya and see the imposing green-tiled Mausoleum of Mevlana & museum, the mystic founder of the Sufi sect (Whirling Dervishes). After Konya Depart for Cappadocia. The strange but beautiful formation of Cappadocia has had this appearance for millions of years. When the volcanoes in the region were active, the lava which poured out covered all previously formed hills and valleys forming a high plateau. It is estimated that there are more than 600 rock-cut churches in Cappadocia. Walls were covered with beautiful frescoes and they were also influenced by the Iconoclast period in the 8th and 9th Century. The underground cities in Cappadocia are unique too. No one knows when the underground cities of Cappadocia were built, perhaps in Hittite times or as late as the 16th Century. Another region worth visiting in the area is the famous Ihlara Valley. Ihlara Valley (Canyon) is a deep, narrow river gorge cut through the tufa by the Melendiz River. The canyon runs for 20 km / 12 miles offering one of the most enjoyable trekking routes to those people who can spare the minimum of half a day. In the canyon there are about 60 churches, monasteries and cells of anchorites. There are also loads of activities available in Cappadicia: hot-air ballooning, horse and camel riding, trekking, the list goes on. Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia.

Day 13 - Cappadocia Off Road SUV Tour

(Breakfast and dinner included)

The full day Cappadocian ATV Tour begins in the deeply set valley town of Urgup and will then drive through to the Uzengi River. The drive will take you through scenery that includes pigeon houses, the grape growing district and the near by wineries of Ortahisar. The ATV tour will then take passengers off the beaten track with a visit to the picturesque caves of the Red Valley. You find seven small lakes in a valley formed as the result of a landslide: Buyukgol (Big Lake), Seringol (Cool Lake), Deringol (Deep Lake), Nazligol (Elegant Lake), Kucukgol (Small Lake), Incegol (Thin Lake) and Sazligol (Reedy Lake). The lakes are on an area of 550 hectares, while the National Park they are located in is 2019 hectares. The area is among the best-known trekking places. That was the first peace treaty where woman ever participated. Dinner and overnight in Hattusa.

Day 8 - Hattusa Tour - Zile Tour - Tokat City

After Breakfast at 08:30 am Visiting Yazilikaya which is the ruin of an open air temple of the Hitites where there are rock carvings of the Hitites god and Goddes. This ancient basilica was built by Constantine the Great in the 4th century and reconstructed by Justinian in the 6th century, it is one of the architectural marvels of all time. After the tour you have the option to experience The Bosphorus Cruise. You will have the chance to enjoy magnificent views of Bosphorus, which connects Asia to Europe. The rest of the evening is your to enjoy Istanbul. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.



Day 3 - Seven Lakes and Abant Lake Tour

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Visiting 7 lakes which are found to be diffirent height points from each other and at the same time connected with each other on foot. You find seven small lakes in a valley formed as the result of a landslide: Buyukgol (Big Lake), Seringol (Cool Lake), Deringol (Deep Lake), Nazligol (Elegant Lake), Kucukgol (Small Lake), Incegol (Thin Lake) and Sazligol (Reedy Lake). The lakes are on an area of 550 hectares, while the National Park they are located in is 2019 hectares. The area is among the best-known trekking places. There are only small bungalows belonging to the Forestry Ministry where visitors who want to linger can stay. Deer and trout production farms are also in the area. An entrance fee is paid according to the type of vehicle and the number of visitors. Tables, firepits and fountains are available for picnickers. Fishing is available in Yedigoller between April 1st and September 1st. We will then have some lunch and depart for Abant Lake. Abant is most probably the most famous lake in Turkey. It is 30 kilometers away from Bolu, and you can reach it from the crossing on the Ankara-Istanbul highway. The lake is at the end of a 22-kilometer drive. The seven-kilometer walk around the lake offers a great opportunity to enjoy the area. Those who don't wish to walk can ride horseback or complete the tour on a horse cart. Abant lake is surrounded with pine trees. The manner in which the lake was formed is a topic of discussion. Its deepest point is 45 meters. The countryside is pleasantly different in each season. Water lilies embellish the surface in summer. It is also famous for its trout. Later, we will have free time for shopping at the bazaar in the village. Dinner and overnight near Abant in traditional village house.

Day 4 - Safranbolu

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast, We have a walk to the historical Safranbolu Bazaar. We then visit Cinci Hodja Caravanserai, Cici Hodja Bath, Kaymakamlar House (Museum), Izzet Mehmet Pashamosque and more. Continue to Kastamonu, we visit government house, Kaya tomb, Seyh Saban-i Veli Mausoleum, Nasrullah Seyh Mosque and more historical sites. Dinner and overnight in authentic wooden houses in Safranbolu.

Day 5 - Ilgarini Cave Pinarbasi

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Today we will depart for Ilgarini Cave, which is in the region of Pinarbasi (northwest of Kastamonu), it is one of the largest caves in Turkey. It is a wonderful place for trekking and exploration off the beaten path. The cave had been composed by two sections. The cave is an active one and the stalactite and stalagmite activity still continues. A chapel and a burial ground was found in this cave. Ilgarini Cave was chosen as the 4th biggest cave in the world. There is no roads to Ilgarini Cave so we will be trekking to the Cave so make sure you bring suitable footwear. Dinner and overnight in Pinarbasi.

Day 6 - Comlekciler Village Horse Riding

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast depart for Comlekciler Koyu this village has fantastic horse riding facilities which you can do as an optional activity. Horse riding is not only for the advanced riders they have lessons and treks for beginners also. This village is rich in natural beauty. All meals are home made the farm produce all their own vegetables, butter and milk. If you are interested in doing a week's horse riding adventure then this can also be arranged. Dinner and overnight in Comlekciler Village.

Day 7 - Kastamonu

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After breakfast we depart for Kastamonu. Kastamonu is a lovely city hidden in the midst of forests in Anatolia. The beauty of the 12th century Byzantine castle at the foot of the hill welcomes you. Also they used horse cartsas their war vehicle which they used during the attack of Ramses the 2nd and they had a big war with the Egyptians and then they made a peace treatywhich they wrote on the clay and had 2 women sign it. This was the first peace treaty in which woman participatied in. Dinner and overnight in Hattusa.

Day 8 - Hattusa to Tokat City

(Breakfast and dinner included)

After Breakfast at 08:30 am Visiting Yazilikaya which is the ruins of open air temple of Hitites where there are rock carving of Hitites god and Goddes. And then we go to Hattusas, big temple and the city ruins including Gates of Lion and king. Visiting summer palace of Hitites. And driving to Alacahoyuk that was first capital of Hitites and Hatti civilisation. After Hattusa Tour depart for Tokat City. Tokat is a city located in the middle Black Sea region of Anatolia, known for its rich history and ancient sites. As you walk through the city, you can experience life as it was in ancient times by exploring its many historical buildings and landmarks. Dinner and overnight in Tokat City at Devecilar Hanı Luxury Boutique Hotel.

After the Sirince tour, we will visit Mount Ida, Turkish Kazdagi, with a meaning of Goose Mountain it is a mountain in northwestern Turkey, and lies southeast of the ruins of Troy, along the north coast of the Gulf of Edremit. The name, Mount Ida, is an ancient one. Dinner and overnight in Kazdagi Village houses.

Day 20 - Kazdaglari (Mount Ida)

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Situated in the West of the province of Balikesir, the Mount Ida of classical mythology retains something of its ancient magic in its delightful trails and waterfalls, its rural charm and scenic views. This mountain has the second best natural Oxygen levels in the world. Today it is a haven for climbers and trekkers. The mountain's healthy climate is also home to a range of arts and crafts, including some which date back to nomadic Turkish tribes. The steep and level tracks, asphalted lanes and gardens of Zeytinli afford the walker a constant permutation of surface and vista. In the Village of the Wooden Birds (Tahtakuslar Koyu), just a few kilometres from Akcay, stands Turkey's first private ethnographical museum and first village art gallery. The legends of the Kaz mountains are told here and the medicinal plants which grow on them can be purchased along with local handicrafts. A kilometre to the Southeast is Sarlak, with its commanding view of Camlibel and the Gulf. Its picnic area and tea garden, containing a pool in the shape of the Sea of Marmara, are an ideal place to gather breath. Mount Ida defined with various names in the Iliada Legend of Homeros have comprised many legends throughout the history with its natural-cultural assets and unique beauties. Besides it's an important attraction center considering the recreation and tourism activities. Dinner and overnight in Kazdagi Village houses.

Day 21 - Assos & Troy Tour

(Breakfast and dinner included)

Assos lies within the village of Behremkale. It is believed that Assos was founded by the people of Methymna in the 7th century B. C. a town on the island of Lesbos. Walls surround the Acropolis, built on a hill dominating both sea and land, about 3 km. in length. These walls were distinctively built at the time expressing different style and workmanship. Try the restaurants and the cafes in the village and also at the harbour. Enjoy the small cobbled beach next to the harbour, swim over the huge remnants of ancient harbour ruins, lying just under the surface of the gentle sea or walk down the cobbled road to the harbour (iskele) and admire the mosaics of a partly excavated byzantine church, as well as the marvellous view on the Greek island of Lesbos and the gulf of Edremit. After lunch depart for Troy



where you can explore the site of the legendary town, made famous by Homer and visit the Temple of Athena. Dinner and overnight in Troy.

Day 22 - Gallipoli Tour - Istanbul
